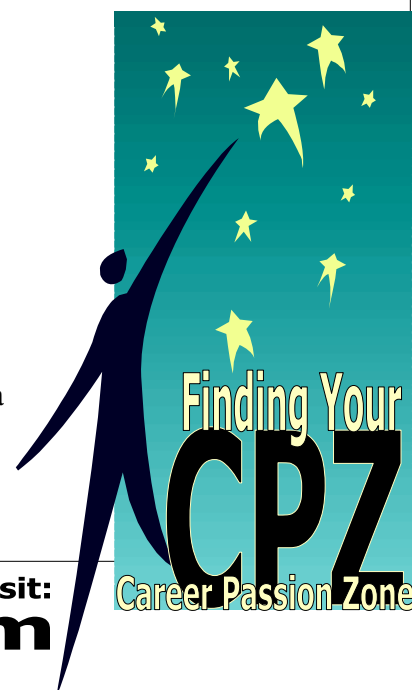


# Finding Your Career Passion Zone
